Responsibilities:

- Complete the reserve and profit analysis for the actuarial processes as part of the GAAP financial close for the reinsurance unit;
- Lead the coordination effort to produce and analyze audited US GAAP financial statements for the Bermuda reinsurance company;
- Design and implement necessary SOX controls to ensure results are accurate for the reinsurance unit;
- Review and manage the control framework regarding the actuarial processes across the different operating units of the Company;
- Develop and manage the actuarial financial planning process for reinsurance unit, and ensure consistency with the rest of the Company;
- Lead the consolidation of the US GAAP actuarial disclosures for SEC reporting;
- Support the oversight of the actuarial process within the GAAP financial close for the entire organization including US operations;
- Ensure consistency in assumptions and methodologies for the Company's financial close process;
- Provide support to modeling of new business opportunities, and lead integration of new deals into the established GAAP reporting process;
- Support the ALM modeling process and communication to senior management by producing key profitability measures, including cost of fund analysis and experience study analysis;
- Provide primary actuarial support for external GAAP audits for the reinsurance segments;
- Audit and evaluate periodically the data provided for each cedent; and
- Manage and lead the Bermuda actuarial GAAP reporting team.
