Substance Misuse Interventions Facilitator – Part-time \$50 per hour

The Department of Corrections is seeking a part-time substance misuse interventions facilitator to work in its facilities: Westgate, Farm and Co-Ed.

Working under the supervision of the Psychologist, the successful applicant will be required to facilitate substance misuse programmes for adult male and female inmates. The facilitator will also provide reports, collect and report statistical data.

The facilitator will be required to work up to 30 hours per week.

Applicants must possess:-

- Certification as an Alcohol and Other Drug Counselor via The Bermuda Addiction Certification Board (an IC&RC affiliate Board) and registration with The Allied Health Council.
- Training in the addiction field, five (5) years of counseling experience and at least three (3) years' experience in direct education and treatment of alcohol and/or other drug related problems. Familiarity with the Cognitive Behavioural Model would be an asset.
- Must be trained to deliver PATHWAYS TO CHANGE: Offender Substance Abuse Programme
- Be computer literate, have good writing and communication skills
- Experience working in a correctional facility or residential setting would be an asset.
