



## **TEACHING OPPORTUNITIES FOR JANUARY 2016**

The Bermuda High School (BHS), an International Baccalaureate World School, caters to students from Year 1 through to Year 13. BHS admits girls only in Years 1 to 11 and boys and girls in Years 12 and 13 (IB1/IB2). The School offers the English National Curriculum through Key Stage 1-3, the GCSE/IGCSE examinations at Key Stage 4, and the IB Diploma programme in the final two years of school. Students may also sit the SAT I and II examinations in IB1/IB2.

This position requires the teaching of Design & Technology at the IB Standard/Higer Levels for the one term only.

### **Teacher of General Sciences and Physics**

All applicants should hold strong academic qualifications: a good honours degree in a teaching subject and teacher training certification. Proven success, formal training and minimum of 3 years' experience in teaching the subject would be a requirement for this vacancy.
