- Support and coach Project Managers and Initiative Leads with professional advice on the design and content of business cases, post-project implementation reviews, project health checks or lessons learned exercises to ensure that proposed benefits are delivered and processes understood
- Prepares and reviews financial reconciliations of MPO expenditures
