

NOTICE OF PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Redevelopment of the L.F. Wade International Airport

An Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA) is being undertaken for the proposed Redevelopment of the L.F. Wade International Airport. The ESIA will identify and assess the environmental and social impacts and benefits (human, built, natural, social and economic) of the proposed redevelopment in order to enable a balanced decision-making process. Consultation during the ESIA allows the whole community to participate in the assessment process, to express their views and concerns, and to properly understand the potential impacts of the proposal.
