## **TECHNICAL COMPLIANCE MANAGER (Public Private Partnership - PPP) REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT OFFICE**

### **Key responsibilities include:**

- Manages Facilities Management (FM) and other technical aspects of the contract with BHB's PPP partner on a day to day basis, with a focus on technical compliance and resolution of issues associated with building, systems, and engineering plant and infrastructure performance under the Project Agreement (PA)
- Liaises closely with, and advises the Assistant Contract Manager on any performance and non-compliance matters which could result in adjustments to the PA's Payment Mechanism
- Manages relationships with stakeholder groups such as BHB clinical staff, BHB support staff, PPP Project Co., PPP Service Provider, Government officers, in emotionally charged situations with proactive check-ins, formal and informal meetings, and resolution of conflicts
- Applies audit processes to, and provides advice and support across other BHB facilities, such as the KEMH General Wing (GW), Mid-Atlantic Wellness Institute (MWI), Acute Care Wing (ACW), etc.
- Acts as the critical BHB technical officer in relation to all mechanical, engineering and building interface issues between ACW and GW
- Reviews monthly performance reports and other performance-related reports received from Project Co. and their Service Provider; highlights issues and concerns with a view to satisfactory resolution

### **Qualifications &/ Registration required:**

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent in a mechanical or electrical engineering discipline, or other related field is essential
- Minimum of five (5) years' experience in the design, construction and/or operations of a large complex PPP-procured, specifically design, building, facilities management, acute healthcare organization is essential

- Thorough demonstrable understanding of AutoCAD software
- Strong Knowledge of Change Management, a builder of consensus, team play
