BR 27 / 2016	
The Minister of Finance, in exercise of the power conferred by section 2 of the Government Fees Act 1965, makes the following Regulations:	
Citation	
1	These Regulations may be cited as the Government Fees (Trade Marks and Service Marks) Amendment Regulations 2016.
Revokes and replaces Schedule	
2	The Schedule to the Government Fees (Trade Marks and Service Marks) Regulations 1993 is revoked and replaced by the Schedule to these Regulations.
Transitional	
3	Nothing in these Regulations affects the validity of a fee that is paid before the coming into operation of these Regulations.
