Under the direction of the Assistant Land Valuation Officer, Stamp Duty Section, the Valuer undertakes statutory appraisals of properties for use by the Tax Commissioner and the Registrar of the Supreme Court for the calculation of both stamp duties and land tax in accordance with the Departmental policies and procedures. The Valuer also maintains the Valuation List including presenting cases at the Land Valuation Appeal Tribunal and the Supreme Court as well as undertaking the quinquennial revaluation of both residential and commercial properties for land tax purposes every five years. The post holder also performs associated duties within the Department, including occasional supervision and administration, in addition to the management of the Trainee Estates Surveyors.

The Postholder must possess a Bachelor's Degree in a relevant subject area and must be a Professional Member of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (Valuation faculty) or equivalent and must be registered or eligible for registration as a surveyor in Bermuda, as required under the Professional Surveyors Registration Act 1997 and possess a valid Bermuda driver's licence for either a motorcycle or a car. A minimum of three (3) years' post-qualification experience with an emphasis on valuations for land tax (or rating) purposes, including appearances before appeals tribunals as an advocate/expert witness, is also required.
