# Notes

- Where a vessel has been hired continuously for a period exceeding twenty-four hours the Authority may reduce the rate in respect of the period exceeding twenty-four hours by an amount not exceeding ten per centum.
- Tender Service to cruise ships is subject to a minimum of-(a) three round trips for the first twelve hour period; and
  - (b) five round trips in any twenty-four hour period.
  - Except in the case of dues specified in Part IV of the Schedule, all charges are subject to a 100 per cent surcharge-
  - (a) on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays; and
    - (b) between 1630 hours and 0800 hours on normal working days.".
