Citation

This Notice may be cited as the Marine Board (Control over Maritime Traffic) Notice 2016.

Interpretation

In this Notice, "Ferry Reach" means all that area from the airfield landing light pylons close to the Bermuda Institute of Ocean Sciences, thence westward along the Reach to a line extending from the north side of the Reach to Little Rogue Island, thence to the eastern edge of Rogue Island, thence south eastwards to Stone Crusher Corner at Kindley Field Park.

Postponement of races

(1) In the event that a race is postponed, the races referred to in paragraph 3 may be held between 12 noon and 5:00 p.m. on the following dates-

(2) The provisions of this Notice apply to a race held on the dates mentioned in subparagraph (1).

Practice races

Commencing on Tuesday 19 April 2016 and ending on Wednesday 2 November 2016, participants in a race may practice weekly at Ferry Reach on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays and Sundays between the hours of 12 noon and 6:00 p.m.

Non-application of speed limits

The speed limits fixed by paragraph 3 of the Marine Board (Declaration of Speed Limits for Boats) (Mariners) Notice 2001 shall not apply to persons and boats participating in the races referred to in paragraphs 3, 4 and 5 during the dates and times therein specified; but general safety precautions must be observed.

Caution to be exercised by mariners

- (1) All mariners, pilots and boatmen must exercise extreme caution while approaching or navigating the waters of Ferry Reach during a race or a practice race.
- (2) A person navigating the waters at Ferry Reach during a race or a practice race shall not exceed 5 nautical miles per hour and in any event shall ensure that they do not create a wake.
- (3) It is an offence under section 10(3)(a) of the Marine Board Act 1962 for the master of a ship or boat to fail to observe the requirements of this Notice.

Patrol of course

Marshal boats shall patrol Ferry Reach and exercise 8 over marine traffic during the races; but practice races will not be patrolled.

THE ROAD TRAFFIC (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) (No. 4) **ORDER 2016**

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister charged with responsibility for Works by Section 7(2A) and (2B) of the Road Traffic Act, 1947, the following Order is hereby made:-

- This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (i) (Variation of Speed Limits) (No. 4) Order 2016.
