2016 Census of Population and Housing E-Census Launch and Use Notice

On 21 May 2016, the Department of Statistics launched the online Census of Population and Housing e-Census application.

During the period 21 May 2016 to 22 June 2016, households with occupants who were usual residents in Bermuda on 20 May 2016, are encouraged to use the information received in the mail from the Department of Statistics to submit their census information on census.bm. Those households which do not have a personal computer, a laptop or a tablet device with Internet access may visit the Department of Statistics for assistance. Smart phones are not recommended for the e-Census application.

Before you visit census.bm it is important for you to note that:

- Usual residents have resided or plan to reside in Bermuda for six months or more as of 20 May 2016.
- Census information is required for usual residents only, and is not based on Bermudian status.
- One member of each residence must serve as the Census household reference person (HRP). In most cases this person will be eighteen years or older and carry responsibility for managing household affairs such as paying bills.
- 4. If you do not receive the email confirmation message within a few minutes of logging into census.bm please check your Spam or Bulk E-Mail folder. The confirmation email may have been delivered to your Spam or Bulk E-Mail folder instead of your inbox. If this occurred select the confirmation message and mark it as Not Spam. This should allow all future messages to be sent directly to your inbox.
