Are you an adventurous and positive person looking to empower Bermuda's youth? Consider joining the crew of STV Spirit of Bermuda!

Bermuda Sloop Foundation (BSF) is the non-profit organisation that operates our national tall ship and sail training vessel, Spirit of Bermuda. Since 2006, our character development programmes have positively impacted over 4,000 young people.

We are seeking **Watch Leaders** for our local and offshore programmes. Successful candidates will possess a strong desire and ability to work with the youth of Bermuda and have the energy, flexibility and mindset necessary to live and work in a unique environment. During the school year, five-day local voyages will begin on a Monday and end on the following Friday in Dockyard. During non-voyage periods, ship daily maintenance, training, or other necessary supporting duties are performed to meet the goals of the programmes.

Previous successful experience in youth development or the maritime field is essential. A high level of motivation, maturity, ability & willingness to learn and thus facilitate student success are qualities we seek. Post-holders aboard Spirit are considered role models for our youth and thus must demonstrate positive character attributes and a strong work ethic.

Short-listed candidates will participate in a local five day-day (four nights) "skiller" voyage August 8-12, 2016 with approximately 18 youth. Offers of employment will be extended to successful candidates subsequent to the voyage and offered a minimum of a one-year contract starting immediately. In addition, participation in an overseas voyage to Rockport Maine via Boston, MA from August 18-25 will be requested.

This is an ideal post for anyone looking to work in the maritime field and make a difference in the lives of Bermuda's young people.
