Reporting to the Chief Executive Officer the Director, Health Economics will have responsibility for all Health Council functions related to oversight and developments in health system financing, economics and insurance.

Job Description

- Oversee the regulation and licensing of health insurers
- Produce the annual National Health Accounts Report
- Commission, evaluate and utilize actuarial reviews
- Analyse data sets to understand patterns of healthcare service utilisation and cost
- Design and conduct publishable studies to meet the Council's mandate, including benefit incidence analyses, population surveys, cost-effectiveness, and burden of disease
- Design and implement data-driven programs that assist in the identification and stratification of high-risk populations
- Manage relationships with external stakeholders and consultants working on projects and publications
- Represent the Council on matters related to health financing
- Supervise staff
- Fulfil the role of Acting CEO on assignment by the CEO

Experience / Qualifications Required

- Doctoral degree in economics, finance or discipline related to health economics from an accredited university
- A minimum of 5 years management and business operations experience
- A minimum of 3 years postgraduate experience in health economics
- Experience working with health systems in international contexts
