Citation
1 These Regulations may be cited as the Limited Liability Company (Forms) Regulations 2016.
Interpretation
2 In these Regulations— “Act” means the Limited Liability Company Act 2016.
Form for certificate of formation
3 For purposes of section 30(1) of the Act, the certificate of formation shall be in Form 1 set out in the Schedule.
Form for certificate of formation with secondary name
4 For purposes of section 30(1)(a) of the Act the certificate of formation with the secondary name shall be in Form 2 set out in the Schedule.
Form for certificate of filing
5 For purposes of sections 30, 32, 36 and 39 of the Act, the certificate of filing shall be in Form 3 set out in the Schedule.
Form for certificate of amendment
6 For purposes of sections 32 and 36 of the Act, the certificate of amendment shall be in Form 4 set out in the Schedule.

IN THE MATTER OF SECTION 17 and 29 OF THE BERMUDA ACT 1974 AND IN THE MATTER OF WILILAM PAUL KING
(PUBLISHED PURSUANT TO SECTION 24B(4) OF THE BERMUDA BAR ACT)
On 14th April 2016 Mr. William Paul King (“Mr. King”) was charged on a single complaint containing four counts of improper conduct contrary to sections 17 (1) (a), 17(1)(c) and 29 of the <i>Bermuda Bar Act 1974 as read with Rules 33 to 35 of Barristers’ Professional Code of Conduct 1981</i> as read with Rules 3,4,5 6 and 8 of the <i>Barristers’ (Accounts and Records) Rules 1976</i> together with a breach of Rule 6 (ii) and 6 (v) of the <i>Barristers’ Professional Code of Conduct 1981</i> .
A Disciplinary Tribunal (the ‘Tribunal’) was appointed pursuant to Section 19 of the Bermuda Bar Act 1974 to hear the charges of improper conduct.
On 14th April 2016 Mr. King plead guilty to the third and fourth charges of professional misconduct, namely:
1. The Respondent accepted that his Firm’s (King & Associates)

Forms for registration of charges
11 For purposes of section 222 of the Act— (a) the particulars to be provided for the registration of a charge shall be in Form 9 set out in the Schedule; and (b) the certificate of registration of a charge shall be in Form 10 set out in the Schedule.
Forms for registration of debentures
12 For purposes of sections 225 and 226 of the Act— (a) the particulars to be provided for the registration of a series of debentures shall be in Form 11 set out in the Schedule; and (b) the certificate of registration of a series of debentures shall be in Form 12 set out in the Schedule.
Forms for memorandum of satisfaction of charges
13 For purposes of section 227 of the Act— (a) the memorandum of complete satisfaction of a charge shall be in Form 13 set out in the Schedule; (b) the memorandum of partial payment or satisfaction of a charge shall be in Form 14 set out in the Schedule; and (c) the memorandum of fact that part of a property or undertaking mortgaged or charged has ceased to form part of the property or undertaking of the limited liability company, shall be in Form 15 set out in the Schedule.
Forms for notice of appointment of receiver or manager and termination of appointment
14 For purposes of section 228 of the Act— (a) the notice of appointment of a receiver or manager shall be in Form 16 set out in the Schedule; and

trust account is and was in deficit by approximately \$1.2 million dollars and that, at the relevant time, the Firm had insufficient trust monies to discharge its obligations to its clients. Further, Respondent through its attorney, by letter dated 24th July 2013, admitted that he was in breach of the Rule 2 of the <i>Barrister’s (Accounts and Records) 1976</i> as regards the requirement to have sufficient balances in his trust account; and
2. The Respondent was not issued with a Practising Certificate for the period from 1st July 2013 onwards, but regardless of this, he continued to practice law and represent a client. In so practising, the Respondent was in breach of Rule (ii) of <i>Barristers’ Professional Code of Conduct 1981</i> . whereby he engaged in conduct which may otherwise bring the profession of Barrister into disrepute.
The remaining two counts were withdrawn.
On the 14 April 2016, the Tribunal considered the appropriate sentence and in accordance with the <i>Bar Disciplinary Tribunal Rules 1997</i> , the Tribunal ordered the following:
(a) Mr. King be suspended from practice for three (3) years (Rule 20(2)(b) as read with Rule 19(2));
(b) Mr. King shall pay the Bermuda Bar Association the sum of \$1,000 by way of contribution to the Professional Conduct Committee’s costs (Rule 23(1))
