Furthermore, the role requires internal and external risk reporting on various structures managed by RenaissanceRe Ventures. The successful candidate will lead quantitative research and development of the ILS trading platform while leveraging RenaissanceRe existing capabilities, help formulate new strategies for the Ventures group, support the implementation of new products, and act as a resource for RenaissanceRe proprietary risk models development (REMS) and group level portfolio aggregation.

Responsibilities include:

- Take the lead and responsibility for maintenance, accuracy and driving the future development of the analytical and database systems employed by RenaissanceRe Fund Management according to the need of the underlying portfolios and positions
 - Support portfolio management and engage in trading activities
 - Support marketing of RenaissanceRe Ventures product offering, participate in investor meetings, attend industry events and keep abreast of market trends
 - Oversee extraction, post-processing and reporting of modeling information regarding assumed and ceded portfolios relevant to the activities of the Ventures group using the RenaissanceRe proprietary risk systems (REMS, GPS, Risk Data Warehouse, etc.)
 - Create and expand RenaissanceRe proprietary risk evaluation and portfolio aggregation software which requires developing programs in Python in a LINUX/UNIX environment as well as proficiency in SWL, Access, Excel and Tableau
 - Investigate, evaluate and make recommendations for current and new catastrophe models
 - Conduct analysis and modeling, concluding with recommendations on assumed primary and retro catastrophe excess of loss submissions, capital market transactions and non-catastrophe risks
- Review, process and make recommendations on secondary market offers in a timely and responsive manner
 - Actively support the Global Risk Capital Management Group
