In addition, applicants should have a basic knowledge measurement (i.e. linear, square, cube and circular) and be able to make relative calculations and a basic knowledge of carpentry and joinery technology and terminology associated with tools, equipment and construction.

The post-holder must be able to carry out with minimal supervision any task associated with the servicing, maintenance and installation of self-contained room units, small packaged units, split air conditioning systems and heat pumps to manufacturer's and the section's specifications and time schedules.

Applicants must possess the Bermuda School Diploma (BSD) or equivalent and have two years' experience as a Tradesman HVAC Class 2 together with completion of an appropriate apprenticeship in HVAC Technology including the Bermuda College certificate in Air-Conditioning and Refrigeration or equivalent. Applicants must have achieved the relevant National Training Board Certification for Air Conditioning and Refrigeration.
