

TEACHING OPPORTUNITY AT BHS

The Bermuda High School (BHS), an International Baccalaureate World School, caters to students from Year 1 through to Year 13. BHS is single-sex for girls only, from Year 1 to Year 11. The IB Programme at BHS is co-ed in Years 12 and 13 (IB1/IB2). The School offers the English National Curriculum through Key Stage 1-3, the (I) GCSE examinations at Key Stage 4, and the IB Diploma programme in the final two years of school. Students may also sit the SAT I and II examinations in IB1/IB2. At BHS we focus on the balanced learner, providing extensive opportunities for advancement in academics, the arts, athletics, community service and leadership development.

Teacher of Information Technology, Business Subjects and SIMS Coordinator. Candidates are sought to teach Information Technology and Business Subjects throughout the Secondary age range including a modified English National Curriculum Key Stage 3, the GCSE/IGCSE and the International Baccalaureate Higher and Standard Levels. This position also involves the strategic school-wide development and coordination of SIMS, an information management system. Candidates must be able to demonstrate a comprehensive knowledge of SIMS, troubleshoot technical issues and facilitate SIMS training for all stakeholders.

All applicants for the above post should hold strong academic qualifications: a degree in the teaching subjects and teacher training certification. Proven success, formal training and minimum of 3 years' experience in teaching the subject would be a requirement. A willingness to contribute to the school's extensive extracurricular programme is essential. Prospective teachers should be effective with the use of technology to enhance learning. All applicants must meet the requirements for the Bermuda Teachers' License.
