Burning Issues

Did you know?

The Clean Air Regulations 1993 states:

You may burn only garden clippings and lawn waste

If the smoke is a nuisance to your neighbours, you must put out the fire at once

You may not burn trash such as garbage, lumber, plastics or furniture either on the ground or in a barrel

If a neighbour's fire is disturbing you, call:

And request that the neighbour be asked to put the fire out.
