

# Burning Issues

## Did you know?

### The Clean Air Regulations 1993 states:

- ▶ You may burn only garden clippings and lawn waste
- ▶ If the smoke is a nuisance to your neighbours, you must put out the fire at once
- ▶ You may not burn trash such as garbage, lumber, plastics or furniture either on the ground or in a barrel
- ▶ If a neighbour's fire is disturbing you, call:

Department of Environmental Health 278-5333

Department of Environmental and Natural Resources 239-2303 or 239-2356  
.....  
And request that the neighbour be asked to put the fire out.
