LABORATORY

Key responsibilities include:

- Performs routine and special stains on blocked samples; performs immunohistochemical staining procedures on selected samples
- Packages and refers blocks/slides to the reference lab for immunohistochemical staining

- Registration with a professional licensing body in medical technology such as ASCP or equivalent
- Must be registered with the Profession Supplementary to Medicine Council as required by Bermuda Law
