Key responsibilities include:

- Rotates through any facility associated with the Bermuda Hospitals Board (BHB) and any section of the Core Lab (includes Hematology/Biochemistry/ Transfusion Services/Microbiology)
- Provides optimal coverage of the laboratory services over a 24 hour period – 7 days a week including public holidays and weekends,
- Operates and maintains the department's equipment in a safe and efficient manner (e.g. LH750, Vitros 5600s, Swing/Saxo, Bactec, etc.). Performs calibrations and quality controls and reports variations from acceptable limits to the Senior Technologist
- Reports and documents in the LIS abnormal or panic results to the appropriate Physician/Ward
- Prepares blood for transfusion (e.g. Pre-op, emergency, etc.)

Qualifications &/ Registration required:

- BSc. – Medical Technology or a registered technologist
- 2-5 years post qualification generalist experience in Haematology, Blood Transfusion, Biochemistry and Microbiology
- Registered with the ASCP, HPC or CSMLS or equivalent
- Registered with the Council for Allied Health professionals and maintains registration by obtaining 24 CEU's every 2 years
- Ability to work irregular hours and meet on call requirements
- Maintains interest in scientific and technical advances
- Demonstrates computer literacy and skills, self-motivated, innovative and flexible
