TEACHING OPPORTUNITIES AT BHS

The Bermuda High School (BHS), an International Baccalaureate World School, caters to students from the Early Years Programme (age 4) through to Year 13 (age 18). BHS is single-sex for girls only, from EYP to Year 11. The IB Programme at BHS is co-ed in Years 12 and 13 (IB1/IB2). The School offers the International Primary Curriculum, the English National Curriculum through Key Stage 1-3, the (I) GCSE curriculum in Years 10 and 11, and the IB Diploma and Courses in the final two years of School. Students may also sit the SAT I and SAT II examinations in IB1/IB2. At BHS we focus on the balanced learner, providing extensive opportunities for advancement in academics, the arts, athletics, community service and leadership development.

We are currently seeking the following teachers for September 2017:

Teacher of Business Subjects, Accounts and Economics and Head of Business Department

This position requires the teaching of Business Subjects, Accounts and Economics to the (I)GCSE Level and Business Management and Economics to the IB Standard/Higher Diploma Levels. As Department Head, the applicant must have extensive experience in leading a Business Department.

All applicants for this post should hold strong academic qualifications: a degree in the teaching subject and teacher training certification. Proven success, formal training and minimum of 3 years' experience in teaching the subject would be a requirement for this vacancy. A willingness to contribute to the school's extensive extracurricular programme is essential. Prospective teachers should be comfortable with the use of technology to enhance learning.

Woodwind Music Teacher (Part-time) – Primary & Secondary Department

This position involves teaching both Primary and Secondary students and preparing these students for ABRSM Exams up to Grade 8, including theory. The successful applicant will also be required to accompany students on the piano, direct ensembles and have excellent sight reading skills.

The successful candidate for this post:

- Must be a qualified and experienced woodwind teacher
- Must have a minimum of ABRSM Grade 8 (or equivalent) in the flute, clarinet and saxophone along with experience teaching Primary and Secondary students
- Must have excellent communication skills, a high level of personal musicianship and enthusiasm about music, along with the ability to motivate and inspire learners
- Must be computer literate
- Must be self-disciplined and well-organised

All applicants for the above posts are asked to provide the following information: Post applied for, full name, date of birth and nationality, full details of Secondary and Higher Education with dates, full qualifications with dates, full details of teaching and other experience and three written professional references with their contact information. One of these references should be from a supervisor at the current place of employment. The successful candidates for all positions will be expected to provide a recent Police background check that demonstrates that they may work in an organisation involving children. All applicants must meet the requirements for the Bermuda Teachers' License. BHS is an equal opportunity employer.
