The Salvation Army is currently seeking to hire a Life Skills Counselor as an extension of its drug rehabilitation program. This person must be a reliable, self-motivated professional, who is willing to work in support of the values, standards, goals and mission of The Salvation Army.

The successful applicant will manage a case load of clients, perform clinical functions, facilitate clients in the recovery community, facilitate crisis situations and problem solving during a twenty (20) hour week.

The successful applicant will also be required to administer relapse prevention, administer family counseling, care management, financial management and facilitate a supportive living environment...all while liaising with related Agencies.

Applicants must possess:

- A Degree in a clinical discipline such as Social Work, Counseling or a related field
- Certification as an Addiction Counselor with the Bermuda Addiction Certification Board or working towards certification
- A minimum of four (4) years counseling experience
- A willingness to train in the Community Reinforcement Approach
