CLOSURE OF BLACKWATCH PASS, PEMBROKE

Wednesday 5th May to Monday 22nd May 2017

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to further inform motorists of the continuation closure of Blackwatch Pass, Pembroke from the junction of North Shore Road to the junction at Marsh Folly Road. This road closure is effective during the period Wednesday 3rd May through to 5:00pm Monday May 22nd, 2017.

This road closure is necessary in order to accommodate the remedial works that are required to make the rock face safe along Blackwatch Pass.

During this period diversion sign will be put in place to encourage motorists to use alternative routes such as Palmetto Road. The number 11 bus that usually uses Blackwatch Pass will be diverted via Langton Hill for both inbound and outbound routes during these works.

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologizes for any inconvenience that may result.
