Reporting to the SVP, Chief Accounting Officer the VP, Finance will be responsible for providing leadership and direction in all areas of finance – accounting, reporting, treasury and risk management.

Primary responsibilities:

- Ability to ensure accurate and meaningful financial information is available on timely basis for management decision-making, planning and forecasting, as well as the preparation of financial and operational reports for executive management
- Prepare annual note disclosures in accordance with IFRS and liaising with the external auditors for the Group
- Driving the production of the quarter-end (and month-end) regulatory process to ensure that the Group complies with the prudential and statistical rules as prescribed by the Bermuda Monetary Authority, Basel Committee on Banking Supervision and Local Government
- Production of monthly capital positions for internal reporting
- Prepare capital information for public disclosure (Pillar 3)
- Address ad-hoc queries from other department regarding capital information
- Responsibility for the production and maintenance of the monthly management information packs for Alco using the Group's ALM system
- Manage and oversee the Treasury back office function
- Other projects as assigned by the SVP, Chief Accounting Officer
