- Assists the Chief of Emergency Services as needed in all duties related to the staffing and management of the KEMH Emergency Department (ED), Lamb Foggo Urgent Care Center and Hyperbaric and Wound Care Unit
- Maintains the duty rosters for the ED and Lamb Foggo Urgent Care Center
- Submits Physician hours to Payroll Office on a monthly basis in conjunction with representatives from the Chief of Staff Office / Vice President for Medical Staff Operations.
- Coordinates the housing, orientation, and remuneration of locum tenens physicians in conjunction with the Human Resources, Hotel Management, and Finance Departments as well as the Vice President of Medical Staff Operations
- Coordinates the orientation of new ED physicians, in conjunction with the Human Resources, Hotel Management, and Finance Departments as well as the Chief of Staff Office / Vice President of Medical Staff Operations
- Assists the Chief, in overseeing the continuing medical education of staff employed in the Emergency Department, Urgent Care Center, as well as the Hyperbaric and Wound Care Unit in conjunction with the Clinical Educator for the Emergency Department and the (Nursing) Staff Development Office
- Provides patient care for two-thirds of the standard clinical hours worked by ED staff physicians as per the Emergency Department Staff Physician Job Description,
- In the absence of the Chief, acts with full authority and responsibility as the Chief of Emergency Services & Hyperbaric Medicine

Qualifications & Registration required:

- Board Certification in Emergency Medicine or equivalent and Board Certification in Hyperbaric and Undersea Medicine
- Current registration with Medical Council in relevant jurisdiction
- Eligible to register with Bermuda Medical Council
- At least 10 years practice experience in Emergency Medicine and 5-10 years management experience in Emergency Medicine

Closing date for applications is: June 21st, 2017. Pre-employment substance abuse screening is mandatory for all successful candidates.
