Key responsibilities include:

- Provide consultations for patients on the inpatient and outpatient services.
- Prescribe and monitor courses of antimicrobial therapy, including HIV care and long-term antibiotics
- Provide recommendations to telephone calls from Emergency Department and Hospital admitting teams
- Clinical evaluation of infectious disease clients to assess side effects and treatment response throughout course of therapy
- Be available to the clinical team as needed or provide telephone advice and/or on-site client review if problems arise-e.g. drug reactions or other unexpected clinical events
- Ensure that the policies and procedures for Infectious Disease Services are implemented
- Provide recommendations by telephone regarding reserved antibiotics pertaining to the Antimicrobial Stewardship Program

Qualifications &/ registration required:

- Board Certified in Infectious Diseases with a preference of 3 years post certification experience, 2 of which in a hospital setting.
- Must be comfortable managing general ID, HIV, infections in the setting of immune compromise and hepatitis cases in the inpatient and outpatient settings
