THE ROAD TRAFFIC (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) (NO. 21) ORDER
SUNDAY, 8th OCTOBER 2017

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister charged with responsibility for Works by Section 7(2A) and (2B) of the Road Traffic Act, 1947, the following Order is hereby made:-

1. (i) This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Variation of Speed Limits) (No. 21) Order 2017.
- (ii) This Order applies to the contestants and to the attendant vehicles to the contestants of the Bermuda Bicycle Association Madison Digicel Time Criteria Race on the Ministry of Public Works roadways to be held on Sunday 8th October 2017.
2. (i) The speed limits fixed by Section 7(2) of the Road Traffic Act, 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the Bermuda Bicycle Association Criterium Race.
- (iii) The roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject at the times specified in the third column of the schedule to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

ADJUSTMENT OF SPEED LIMIT

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to inform motorists that the Bermuda Bicycle Association will be holding a Criterium race on Sunday 8th October 2017 between the hours of 8:00 am & 11:45 am on Southside Roads in St Davids.

The Bicycle race route is as follows:

Start on Southside Road heading east until the reaching the roundabout at the junction of Pepper Hall Road, taking a left turn and continuing north, a left turn onto Tommy Fox Road and then another left back onto Southside Road until reaching race start & finish line.

On the race route only between the hours of 8:00 am and 11:45 am the speed limit will be raised to 75km/hr to accommodate the speeds of the cyclists.

It is proposed to close the roads during this race but allow access by exception for emergency vehicles and business owners under the direction of Police, Race officials' and Marshals. Motorists are advised to use caution and to give priority to cyclists. Motorists are also advised to follow directions given by the Police and Race Officials.

There will be no parking restrictions in place during the bicycle race and motorists are permitted to park in designated parking bays along the race route. Motorists are requested to show consideration for the participants by not impeding them or blocking the race route.

The Ministry of Public Works wishes to encourage the full cooperation of the motoring public and apologizes for any inconvenience that may result.
