## **General Practitioner Physicians**

*Duties and Responsibilities may include but are not limited to:*

1. Collaborating with specialist physicians and assisting in the management, development and coordination of care of patients with subacute and chronic illnesses.
2. Assisting with the various clinical programs including medical weight management, infusion therapy, cardiopulmonary testing, neurophysiological testing, peripheral vascular screening
3. Assisting in the implementation of clinical pathways, protocols and other clinical effectiveness projects as well as assisting in the provision of patient counselling and health education.
4. Participating in the screening of patients for disease risk factors and early signs of illness
5. Providing accurate, timely documentation in the patient's electronic medical record
6. Assisting with planning to evaluate performance levels, quality of service, productivity/ future needs of the practice.
7. All other activities as directed by the Medical Director.

*Qualifications and required skills include:*

- Awarded degree of MD, DO, Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MB, BS) recognized family medicine residency (3 years minimum) or satisfy the clinical and examination requirements to function as a general practitioner as outlined by the Bermuda Medical Council.
- Current Certification in Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Care Life Support (ACLS)

## **Dietician**

Clinical experience treating overweight and obese adults and the ability to provide dietary services which focus on obesity and weight management are essential in this role.

*Duties and responsibilities may include but are not limited to:*

- Preparing for patient counseling by reviewing medical records to obtain information such as the physician's diagnosis, diet orders, medication(s) prescribed, etc.
- Assessing patients' health needs and diet through interviews, observation, and/or review of patient/client records
- Conferring with physician(s) psychologist, and other health care professionals
- Writing reports to document patient/client progress: recording observations and other pertinent information for inclusion in the medical record
- Developing, communicating and participating in bariatric support groups
- Participating in the marketing activities, promoting the medical weight loss program
- Keeping up with the latest nutritional science research

*Qualifications and required skills include:*

- Bachelor's degree in Dietetics or equivalent
- Registration as a registered dietitian by an accredited, recognized governing body
- Certification in obesity and weight management is preferred or evidence of clinical experience in treating overweight and obese adults
- Experience in using psychological /behavioural mgmt. approaches in clinical management of obesity
- Clinical experience in group treatment of overweight/obesity
- At least 3 years' experience as a dietitian providing services to individual patients and groups
- Evidence of professional/ personal development and evidence working in a multidisciplinary team
- Solid computer skills, including Microsoft Excel, Word, and Outlook
- Previous experience with an electronic patient record is essential
