## **TRAFFIC NOTICE REMEMBRANCE DAY PARADE**

**Saturday, 11<sup>th</sup> November 2017**

The City of Hamilton wishes to advise the general public, motorists and businesses that the following road closures and parking restrictions will be in place for the Bermuda Regiment to conduct its Parade.

### **Roads Closed – 10:00am to 12:00 Noon**

Front Street from King Street to Queen Street  
Court Street from Reid Street to Front Street

### **No Parking – 6:00am to 12:00 Noon**

Front Street from King Street to Queen Street  
No.1 Car Park

Motorists entering the City from the **EAST** are advised to detour up Spurling Hill. Access to shops on Front Street between Spurling's Hill and Court Street will be allowed. Motorists entering the city from the **WEST** are advised to detour up Queen Street.

In addition, The Bermuda Police Service is authorised to close off streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
