TEACHING OPPORTUNITIES AT BHS

BHS, an International Baccalaureate School based in Bermuda, is an all-girls school from the Early Years Programme to Year 11 and offers an IB co-ed programme in Years 12 and 13 (IB1 & IB2). The School offers the International Primary Curriculum, the English National Curriculum through Key Stage 1-3, the (I)GCSE curriculum in Years 10 and 11, and the IB Diploma and Courses in the final two years of the School. Students may also sit the SAT examinations in IB1/IB2.

At BHS we focus on the balanced learner, providing extensive opportunities for advancement in academics, the arts, athletics, STEAM, community service and leadership development. BHS promotes a student-centred approach to pedagogy and learning.

We are currently seeking the following for June 1st, 2018:

Part-time Teacher of French and Spanish

This position requires the teaching of French and Spanish from Years 7 to 9 and at the GCSE/IGCSE and the IB Diploma Standard/Higher levels or equivalent.

We are currently seeking the following for September 2018:

Teacher of French and Spanish, Secondary Assistant VLE Coordinator

This position requires the teaching of French and Spanish from Years 7 to 9 and at the GCSE/IGCSE and the IB Diploma Standard/Higher levels or equivalent. As Secondary Assistant VLE Coordinator, this post involves providing support for Secondary staff to optimise their use of the School's VLE (Virtual Learning Environment) in order to enhance their teaching and learning.

Teacher of Latin/ Classical Civilisation, Mathematics, and Examination Officer

This position requires the teaching of Latin and Classical Studies across the 11 -14 age range (I)GCSE and IB Standard/ Higher Levels. Additionally, one may teach Mathematics across the 11 -14 range. As Examinations Officer, this post requires the overall co-ordination of the School's internal and external examinations.

Teacher of English, Theory of Knowledge & Film Studies and Department Head of English, Yearbook Co Advisor, VLE Coordinator

This position requires the teaching of English from Years 7-9 and at the (I)GCSE and IB Diploma Standard/Higher levels. The successful applicant must have extensive experience in leading an English Department. Experience in teaching IB Theory of Knowledge would be an advantage. This position also requires assisting with the publication of the School's Yearbook and involves the responsibility of further developing the use of the School's VLE (Virtual Learning Environment) to enhance teaching and learning.

Teacher of History & Theory of Knowledge

This position requires the teaching of History from Years 7 to 9 and at the GCSE/IGCSE and the IB Diploma Standard/Higher levels. Additionally, the successful candidate will be required to teach IB Theory of Knowledge.

Teacher of Mathematics, Chemistry & Science

This position requires the teaching of Mathematics, Chemistry and Science from Years 7 to 9 and at the GCSE/IGCSE and the IB Diploma Standard/Higher levels. The successful candidate may also teach SAT Mathematics.

Teacher of Mathematics & Head of Year

This position requires the teaching of Mathematics from Years 7 to 9 and at the GCSE/IGCSE and the IB Diploma Standard/ Higher levels, in addition to SAT Mathematics. This position also involves the pastoral leadership of a Year group. Previous leadership experience in this role would be a requirement.

All applicants should hold strong academic qualifications: a degree in the teaching subject and teacher training certification. Proven success, formal training and a minimum of 3 years' experience in teaching the subject(s) would be a requirement for this vacancy. A willingness to contribute to the school's extensive extracurricular programme is essential. Prospective teachers should also be comfortable with the use of technology in the classroom. All applicants must meet the requirements for the Bermuda Teachers' License.
