TEACHING OPPORTUNITIES AT BHS

BHS, an International Baccalaureate School based in Bermuda, is an all-girls school from the Early Years Programme to Year 11 and offers an IB co-ed programme in Years 12 and 13. The School offers the International Primary Curriculum, the English National Curriculum through Key Stage 1-3, the (I)GCSE curriculum in Years 10 and 11, and the IB Diploma and Courses in the final two years of the School. Students may also sit the SAT examinations in IB1/IB2.

At BHS we focus on the balanced learner, providing extensive opportunities for advancement in academics, the arts, athletics, STEAM, community service and leadership development. BHS promotes a student-centred approach to pedagogy and learning.

We are currently seeking the following for September 2018:

Head of the Mathematics Department and Teacher of Mathematics

Mathematics is a key part of our STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Design and Maths) initiative. As such, our dynamic Head of Mathematics will become an integral part of this exciting curriculum development. The successful applicant will teach from Year 7 to Year 13 including (I)GCSE and IB Standard/Higher Diploma Levels. There is an expectation that the American style SAT Mathematics will be integrated into the Mathematics programme. This position requires that the successful candidate has had previous leadership experience in Mathematics and a genuine desire to develop the subject within our STEAM initiative.

Head of the Business Department and Teacher of Business Subjects, (Accounts, Economics and Business)

Business subjects are extremely important in Bermuda and BHS is committed to ensuring our students develop a passion for and experience in a variety of Business Subjects. The successful applicant must have extensive experience in leading a Business Department and teach, with passion, Business Studies, Accounts and Economics to the (I)GCSE Level and Business Management and Economics to the IB Standard/Higher Diploma Levels. Linking all learning to the real world is a crucial aspect of this role.

Head of the Physical Education Department and Teacher of Physical Education

We require a Head of Physical Education who has an infectious enthusiasm for the subject and will co-ordinate the Physical Education programme across the Primary and Secondary divisions. The successful candidate will be able to coach our students in a variety of different sports (including: Netball, Basketball, Volleyball, Softball, Track and Field and Fitness Training), but must have an in-depth knowledge and strength in Netball. Experience teaching the new GCSE Edexcel Physical Education is also essential. The successful candidate will have a keen interest in establishing students' leadership skills in PE. An integral part of this position is demonstrating the ability to coach teams and co-ordinate the extra-curricular sports programme at BHS.

Teacher of French and Spanish

This position encompasses the teaching of French and Spanish across the 10 -14 age range and at the (I)GCSE level. Additionally, the successful applicant will teach French at the IB Standard/Higher Diploma Levels. The ability to develop a student's passion for language learning is essential in this role.

Teacher of Geography, Humanities and Environmental Systems and Societies

At BHS, we are in the process of developing some transdisciplinary Humanities units. This position will involve teaching Geography and Humanities across the 11-14 age range and Geography at the (I) GCSE and IB Standard/Higher Diploma levels. In addition, experience in teaching IB Environmental Systems and Societies would be an advantage

All applicants for the above posts should hold strong academic qualifications: a degree in the teaching subject and teacher training certification. Proven success, formal training and a minimum of 3 years' experience in teaching the subject would be a requirement for these vacancies. A willingness to contribute to the school's extensive extracurricular programme is essential. Prospective teachers should be comfortable with the use of technology to enhance learning. All applicants must meet the requirements for the Bermuda Teachers' License. BHS is an equal opportunity employer.
