The post holder will oversee and have responsibility for Disaster Management and Emergency Response for BHB and work alongside key Government and community stakeholders. Responsibilities will require the post holder to maintain BHB at a level of readiness for potential emergency and disasters and be the Lead Physician during training, simulations and actual emergencies and disasters

Key responsibilities include:

- Serves as Chairperson of the BHB Disaster Management Committee
- Serves as the Lead Physician to the Emergency Management Organization (EMO), Pan American Health Organization (PAHO) and Hospital Incident Command Centre (HICC)
- Collaborates with the Operations Manager for all disaster related equipment, operational guides and communication
- Assists with coordinating regional exercises and drill design, implementation, evaluation and reporting
- Administrative responsibility as needed in all duties related to the staffing and management of the KEMH Emergency Department, Lamb Foggo Urgent Care Center and Hyperbaric and Wound Care Unit
- Shares the responsibility for the rota and payroll and submits Physician hours to Payroll Office and Chief of Staff Office monthly
- Assists the Chief, in overseeing the continuing medical education of staff employed in the Emergency Department, Urgent Care Center in conjunction with the Clinical Educator for the Emergency Department and the (Nursing) Staff Development Office

Qualifications & Registration required:

- Board certified or Board eligible in Emergency Medicine or equivalent
- Formal training in Mass Casualty Management/Disaster Response
- At least 10 years practice experience in Emergency Medicine
- 5-10 years management experience in Emergency Medicine
- At least 5 years training and supervisory and field experience in Mass Casualty Management/Disaster Response
- Current registration with Medical Council in relevant jurisdiction
- American College of Emergency Physicians, College of Emergency Medicine (UK), Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons (Canada), or Australasian College of Emergency Medicine preferred
