Claims Analyst

The Claims Analyst is responsible for the day-to-day processing and handling of claims in Bermuda (for assumed and ceded reinsurance) and for assisting with the preparation of management reporting on respective claims activities.

Responsibilities include:

- Proactively review large losses and assemble RenaissanceRe exposures via available system data
- Ensure all property, casualty, and specialty claims are analyzed for the coverage and exposure with ability to communicate/present all pertinent claim and program details to internal stakeholders
- Perform day-to-day claims processing activities, including:
 - Analyze large losses and evaluating Company exposure across multiple lines of business
 - Review claim payments and reserves, and communicate significant movements to the Claims Manager and Underwriting team as appropriate
 - Process claims and recoveries into the claims system, including reinstatement premium and reinstatement premium accruals, as well as LOC requests in a timely and accurate manner
 - Prepare monthly, quarterly, and pre-renewal account reports
 - Assist with claim audit opportunities and summarize audit findings
 - Assist with inactive claims reviews, liaise with the brokers for updated information and ensure that any changes are reflected in the claims system appropriately
 - Take initiative with special projects or ad-hoc tasks that may be required by either internal or external parties
