- Assist in the completion of the quarterly capital requirements and annual regulatory filings;
- Provide primary actuarial support for external and internal audits;
- Implement and maintain controls to mitigate financial and operational risk for the reserving function;
- Update and analyze GAAP and statutory planning projections and provide comparisons to actual results;
- Assist in the integration of new reinsurance business into the reserving process;
- Assist in the quantification and communication of actuarial risks for the liability portfolio as part of the overall risk framework for the company; and
- Support the build-out and on-going validation of the asset cash flows from the asset manager into the asset/liability models.
