 Supervise students on daily walks, community-based
- outings, as well as physical education and swimming activities

 Develop and lead students in daily mindfulness and social
- Approach teaching in a team-centered environment
- Attend events outside of school hours such as: weekly staff meetings, open houses and professional development sessions
- Enjoy working with children in a busy educational setting
