The candidate will show evidence of working autonomously, be computer literate with Word, Excel and EMR systems, and have a good understanding of ICD-9 and CPT coding. Must possess good organizational skills and be able to work flexible hours as needed.

Evidence of postgraduate physiotherapy qualification preferably M-level with understanding of manual therapy, orthopaedic medicine and acupuncture. Evidence of postgraduate manual therapy skills is a requirement. Dry needling skills are desirable, but not a necessity. Flexible working hours are required for this position including potential for overseas travel with sports teams, athletes, evening and weekend clinics.
