The successful candidate must feel comfortable teaching practical science lessons in a science laboratory environment. There is also an expectation to offer a variety of co-curricular sports and activities after school and at lunch times and will be prepared to take on responsibility for the coordination of science across the Primary School. Excellent inter-personal skills are essential and applicants must be team players.

All applicants should hold a relevant undergraduate degree preferably aligned with the subject they will be teaching in addition to a professional teaching qualification (PGCE or equivalent) at the appropriate school level (Primary or Secondary) and be able to show recent teaching experience in the educational programmes offered at Warwick Academy (UK National Curriculum, IGCSE/GCSE, BTEC and International Baccalaureate; or equivalents).
