



The Regulatory Authority of Bermuda (the “Authority”) invites applications for the role of Regulatory Financial Analyst. Reporting to the Head of Regulatory Finance and working closely with Senior Management, this position provides the opportunity to work in a challenging and expanding regulatory environment, with significant career development opportunity. The Regulatory Financial Analyst will be responsible for the financial analysis and reporting of regulatory financial data filings as well as provide assistance on regulatory matters for the regulated sectors.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

1) Market Data Collection and Reporting:

- Gathering, analyzing and reporting on financial information, operating statistics and their impacts for the development of regulatory strategies and monitoring of the electricity sector and electronic communications sector.

2) Electricity Filings:

- Assist with evaluating very complex financial reports and petitions for changes in rate, tariffs or service from licensees in the Electricity Sector;
- Assist with the reviews to evaluate retail tariff review filings, testimony and financial schedules to verify rate of return and revenue requirements, depreciation expenses and other pertinent financial considerations;
- Assist with the review of monthly cost reconciliation filings, data responses, ordered compliance filings and other similar non-tariff review filings;
- Assist with compliance of all applicable requirements concerning rates and economic performance of licensees; and
- Carry out any other duties the Head of Regulatory Finance or its designate may assign from time to time.

Minimum Qualifications, Experience and Skills:

- Requires a bachelor’s degree in finance, accounting, economics, mathematics or related fields from an accredited college or university;
- Internationally recognized professional accounting, financial or business analyst designation preferred. Examples include, but are not limited to, Chartered Professional Accountant, Certified Financial Analyst and Certified Business Analysis Professional;
- Experience in an Analyst role within a Regulatory environment is advantageous;
- 5 years related working experience;
- Strong working knowledge and experience with Microsoft Office and ability to develop ad hoc reports and run data queries;
- Demonstrated ability to solve problems and offer solution-based recommendations;
- Superior communication, prioritization, and organization skills; and
- Experience with meeting regular reporting deadlines, with an ability to meet deadlines and to work weekends / public holidays when necessary.
