**CLINICAL SUPERVISOR (Mid-Atlantic Wellness Atlantic)

Under the direction of the Clinical Director, the successful candidate will be responsible for the delivery of safe patient care as well as maintaining operational aspects of patient care in collaboration with other service areas.

Key responsibilities include:

- Directing and coordinating activities of Patient Care Administration, assuming responsibility for the performance of the discipline and resolving issues that impact patient care on a daily basis
- Recommending, developing and implementing policies and procedures, delivering safe patient care and customer service, leading the delivery with an interdisciplinary approach to patient care
- Supporting new employees by observing demonstration of clinical competencies, applying progressive disciplinary processes, completing orientation and evaluations and identifying talent for succession planning
- Managing and accounting for allocated budget performance and labour costs for discipline and reporting any resource needs

Qualifications & Registration required:

- Bachelor's Degree in an Allied Health Discipline with a minimum of three years post graduate experience. Master's degree preferred
- Diploma in Supervisory Management (or equivalent) preferred
- Advanced Certification in Mental Health is an asset
- Current licensure and registration as required by Allied Health Council

**ART THERAPIST (Mid-Atlantic Wellness Atlantic)

Key responsibilities include:

- Planning, designing, scheduling and conducting art activities to effect improvement in the mental and social well-being of patients
- Determining and implementing appropriate art therapy for individual and/or groups
- Providing a trusting environment in which patients are able to safely express themselves through the creative art process
- Observing patient's behaviour during art therapy treatment program in an order to assess and document patient's progression or regression
- Encouraging patients to express themselves, to explore their art work and the process of its production. Constructively challenging the behaviour and attitude of clients

Qualifications & Registration required:

- Master's Degree in Art Therapy or be a licensed clinical social worker or licensed professional counsellor with coursework and training equivalent to that of a Master's degree in Art Therapy
- Minimum 1 year working in experience with Mental Health and/or Developmental Disability population health
- Must be registered with the Health Professions Council (HPC) and the British Association of Art Therapists (BAAT) in the UK, Canadian Art Therapy Association (CATA) or the American Art Therapy Association (AARTA) in the USA

**CLINICAL DIETITIAN (FULL- TIME, LOCUM)

Key responsibilities include:

- Serving as nutrition consultant to the health care team(s) and providing direct and indirect nutrition care to patients
- Identifying and assessing patients that are at nutritional risk, patients on therapeutic diets and patients with complex medical conditions for individual needs
- Monitoring patient's progress for efficacy of nutritional intervention, provides reassessment of nutritional status, and adjusts nutrition care plan according to established protocols
- Providing counselling and education to patients/significant others regarding drug-nutrient interactions, nutrition intervention or therapeutic diets as appropriate.
- Responding to nutrition Consults from physicians and the health care team and initiates the nutrition care process
- Promoting the team approach through participation in patient care rounds and discharge planning meetings

Qualifications & Registration required:

- Bachelor or Masters of Science from an accredited University with a major in Nutrition/Dietetics with a minimum of one-year post internship experience in a clinical hospital setting, within the past three years
- Local registration to practice with the Council for Allied Health Professions (CAHP) and meet all re-registration requirements
- Must demonstrate ability to provide independent clinical nutrition care services to a wide range of patients with simple to very complex medical nutritional therapy

**OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST (FULL- TIME, LOCUM)

Key responsibilities include:

- Meeting productivity standards set by the department for direct patient contact and other related non-patient contact duties
- Performing an appropriate assessment on all in and/or outpatients following referral; use objective clinical measures to identify problems and formulate treatment plans based on realistic stated goals; carry out specific therapeutic interventions as indicated
- Supervising and delegating specific written treatment plans to aides, assistants, and/or students
- Observing and evaluating treatment effect; communicating patient progress or lack of to appropriate staff and physicians
- Maintains patient documentation using the appropriate paper work, ensuring documentation meets current standards and policies; prepares specific clinical reports as requested
- Keeps accurate and timely statistics of both direct and indirect time spent and prepares specific clinical reports as required

Qualifications & Registration required:

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited university required with certification, if applicable, in jurisdiction of training
- 1 – 2 years post-graduate experience in a related Occupational Therapy environment, preferably within a hospital
- Local registration to practice with the Council for Allied Health Professions (CAHP)
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills; liaison with other members of the multidisciplinary team to ensure continuity of care
