Secondary Teacher of Food & Nutrition/ Technology, Head of Department

A teacher is required to teach Food & Nutrition/Technology across all classes within the Secondary school, preparing students for IGCSE at the end of Year 11 and the BTEC Hospitality Course in Years 12 & 13. At least 3 years' experience in the teaching of Food & Nutrition/Technology to GCSE/IGCSE and BTEC Hospitality are essential along with proven examination success. This position also includes the Head of Department responsibility relating to Practical Arts and BTEC.

Secondary Teacher of Learning Enrichment

As a result of restructuring and growth an additional Learning Enrichment teacher is required to work as part of a team within the Secondary school. We encourage those who may be looking at working part-time or full-time to apply for this role. The post requires at least 3 years' experience working in a Learning Enrichment role and familiarity with developing Individual Education Plans (IEPs), delivering differentiated strategies, interpreting educational psychologist reports as well as a broad understanding of learning differences/gifted and talented programmes. Knowledge and experience of applying for Board examination accommodations would be an advantage. The responsibilities for this post would include but not limited to:

- Development of IEPs
- Individual and small group support
- Adapting materials / lessons to meet specific needs
- Collaborating with service providers, teachers and parents
- Maintenance of data and documentation
- Conducting observations and follow – up / Parent Teacher Conferences
- Conducting screenings and assessment

All applicants should hold a relevant undergraduate degree preferably aligned with the subject they will be teaching in addition to a professional teaching qualification (PGCE or equivalent) at the appropriate school level (Primary or Secondary) and be able to show recent teaching experience in the educational programmes offered at Warwick Academy (UK National Curriculum, IGCSE/GCSE, BTEC and International Baccalaureate; or equivalents). Applicants must be able to relate positively to students, teaching staff and parents with proven external examination success being an essential component. Candidates must also be prepared to contribute to the school's co-curricular programmes.
