MEDICAL ASSISTANTS – Seeking experienced Medical Assistants with superior customer service skills to assist in the delivery of patient care. The Medical Assistants will perform clinical and administrative duties. The successful applicant will possess a high school diploma or equivalent along with certification from an accredited Medical Assistant program. Candidates should hold valid BLS or ACLS certifications or equivalent certification and have a minimum of two years experience in a healthcare organisation. Strong I.T. skills are required along with knowledge of ICD-9 and ICD-10. The chosen candidate will have excellent communication skills both written and oral. Short-listed candidates will be required to complete a skills test.

REGISTERED NURSES - In this role the successful candidate carries out patient care responsibilities with emphasis on decision-making related to the steps in the nursing process to include assessment, diagnosis, and identification of expected outcomes, planning, implementation and evaluation. Provides competent, safe and compassionate care based on established BMSG Patient Care and Nursing Standards. Applicants must be a graduate of a Registered Nurse Education Programme recognized by the Bermuda Nursing Council and have two years recent experience in a clinical setting.

ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSES – The Advanced Practice Nurse (APN) examines patients, performs comprehensive physical examinations, and compiles patient medical data, including health history and results of physical examination. He/she will collaborate with physicians regarding patient management and high-risk/complex treatment cases and will administer or order diagnostic tests, such as x-ray, electrocardiogram, and laboratory tests, and interpret test results for deviations from normal. Providing education and counselling to patients and their family members regarding the disease process, tests, therapy regimens, maintenance of health, prevention of illness will be a key requirement of the role. Applicants must be a graduate from an accredited Masters of Science program and have graduated from an accredited Nurse Practitioner's or Advanced Practice Nurse program and meet the Bermuda Nursing Council's requirements for licensure as an Advanced Practice Nurse.

AESTHETICIAN – We require a highly skilled aesthetician who will provide safe and effective laser treatments to include hair removal, brown spot and spider vein removal, tattoo removal, skin rejuvenation and resurfacing. The aesthetician will also provide services to include but not limited to radiofrequency skin treatments, micro needling, PRP, dermaplaning, non-invasive fat reduction treatments, waxing, facials, extractions and chemical peels as needed. The incumbent will possess a thorough knowledge of the skin with the ability to evaluate, provide assessments and teach clients about customized skin care regimens and aesthetic services. Applicants must have completed an accredited aesthetics program and hold certification to perform laser treatments. Three years post certification experience is required.

DIETICIAN - Conducts comprehensive nutrition assessment and develops and implements individualized plans for medical nutrition, wellness and weight management therapy in accordance with the patient's medical program goals and objectives. Candidates should have a Bachelors Degree in Nutrition Management or the equivalent and three years relevant experience.

DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING TECHNICIAN (Cardiac) – Conducts EKG, stress tests, and related cardiac diagnostics. The ability to perform echocardiograms will be an advantage. The applicant should possess a minimum of an associates degree in a clinical measurement science in a health related field. Certification in cardiac rhythm management is required and three years recent experience.

DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING TECHNICIAN (Ultrasound) - Performs imaging and Doppler ultrasound examinations on various organs and surrounding anatomy by means of two-dimensional or three-dimensional imaging. The applicant should possess a minimum of an Associates degree in a Clinical Measurement Science in a health related field. Certification in Sonography is required and three years recent experience.

SLEEP TECHNICIAN (Polysomnographer) – Performs diagnostic night-time and day-time sleep studies according to recognised international protocols. Successful completion of an accredited program in leading to a certificate or associate degree with an emphasis in sleep technology. Holds international recognised certification/registration in performing sleep diagnostics. Minimum of two-years recent continuous experience in a sleep disorders centre. Meets respective requirements for the Bermuda Allied Health Professionals Council registration

GENERAL PRACTITIONER - In collaboration with specialist physicians, the General Practitioner will manage the care of patients with subacute and chronic illnesses. Clinical programs will include medical weight management, infusion therapy, cardiopulmonary testing, neurophysiological testing and peripheral vascular screening. Applicants should possess the degree of MD, DO, Bachelor of Medicine or Bachelor of Surgery (MB, BS). Possess board certification from a recognized family medicine residency (3 years minimum) or satisfy the clinical and examination requirements to function as a general practitioner as outlined by the Bermuda Medical Council.

INTERNAL MEDICINE PHYSICIANS – We require Internal Medicine Physicians with special interests in the following sub disciplines: pulmonology, cardiology, rheumatology, neurology, endocrinology, dermatology, obesity and metabolic medicines. Applicants should possess the degree of MD, DO, Bachelor of Medicine or Bachelor of Surgery (MB, BS) or equivalent. Must have board certification or equivalent in Internal Medicine with three years post board certification experience.

DERMATOLOGISTS – We require an experienced practitioner of dermatology who will diagnosis the full range of dermatology conditions and initiate medical and surgical treatments. Applicants must possess the degree of MD or DO or Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MB, BS) or the equivalent. Candidates must be board certified in Dermatology or hold an equivalent certification. A minimum of five years post board certification is required.

NEUROLOGIST/NEUROPHYSIOLOGIST – We require a Neurologist/Neurophysiologist with a special interest in peripheral neurology or possesses qualifications in neurophysiology testior electrodiagnostic medicine to include EMG, EEG and NCS.. Must have certification in Neurology or Neurophysiology. Applicants must possess the degree of MD, DO, Bachelor of Medicine or Bachelor of Surgery (MB, MS) or equivalent. Must have board certification or equivalent with five years post board certification experience.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL POSITIONS:

- If applicable applicants must meet the requirements for the relevant statutory body in Bermuda
- Possess experience with medical coding (ICD-9, ICD-10 & CPT)
- Has a high level of computer literacy and have previously worked with an electronic medical records system
