- Assist in analyzing and ensure the correct application of those contracts to the relevant inwards & outwards contracts; thus ensuring prompt and accurate reinsurance reporting
- Assist in ensuring all premiums and losses are processed and settled promptly in accordance with broker, company and contractual timetables
- Coordinating amongst various functional departments (including claims, underwriting, risk management, actuarial and finance) and Group divisions
- Assist in managing the collateral requirements of the various inwards & outwards reinsurance contracts with internal & external parties
- Assist in producing reinsurance performance analysis for the QBE Group, for board reporting, management information and to aid business planning
- Developing and supporting the relationship between the Company and its assumed and ceded / internal and external reinsurance partners
- Providing superior service and best practice standards to brokers, clients and colleagues, to improve efficiency and customer satisfaction
- Executing on internal controls; assist in maintaining an effective internal control environment
- Supporting Finance team in monthly close processes as well as cash application and collection
