Sailing Director

The Royal Hamilton Dinghy Club is seeking a Sailing Director to lead all aspects of our year round sailing program. This key position is responsible for overseeing the Adult and Youth programs. Responsibilities will include establishing safe boating practices, supervising all sailing personnel, knowledge of all Club owned boats to include: Optimist, Open Bics, Lasers, 420s, 29ers, J024s, Nacra 15s, coach boats and privately owned boats, controlling labor costs, and budgeting.

- Minimum of 5 years' sailing experience in a similar position
- Strong sailing, teaching, and leadership experience
- Recognized sailing qualifications
- US Sailing Small Boat Level 1 qualifications
- Keel Boat Instructor qualifications
- US Sailing level 1 Instructor Trainer qualifications
- Power Boat Instructor qualifications
- Strong background in staff training to achieve and develop desired coaching levels
- Proven track record of P&L budget management
- Knowledge of performing repairs to sail boats
- First Aid, CPR & AED certification
- Must be proficient in computer skills and have a working knowledge of Word and Excel
- Highly organized and possess excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Fluency in English both verbal and written

Sailing Coach

We require an experienced sailing coach to join our year-round program. The successful applicant will report to the Sailing Director, and will be responsible for the management of all waterfront instruction, sailing and powerboat instruction, sailing center administration, and assist in running the center to international standards with a focus on safety and excellent customer service.

Candidates must have 5 years of experience in teaching at all levels, from "Learn to Sail Intro", "Learn to Sail" to high performance and racing in Optimist, 420s, J24s and Open Bics, plus the ability to mentor junior instructors. Previous team and center management experience is essential. US Sailing level 1 qualification is mandatory. Previous experience coaching children and adults to race at an international standard in dinghies is required.
