



TEACHING POSITIONS

Warwick Academy is an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School and Council of International Schools (CIS) Member school catering to students from Reception through to Year 13. The school offers an Early Years Programme, International Primary Curriculum (IPC) from Years 1 to 9, the UK National Curriculum and IGCSE/GCSE examinations in Year 10 & 11 and the IB Diploma, IB Individual Subjects and BTEC programme in Year 12 & 13. In addition the school has vibrant Music, Drama, Sport and Community Service programmes and offers a variety of additional co-curriculars.

Required for September, 2019:

Primary Teacher of French and Spanish & Humanities Co-Ordinator

This position involves teaching French and Spanish throughout the Primary School from Reception through Year 6, and to assist with the transition to the UK National Curriculum Key Stage 3 and IGCSE in the Secondary School. This position also includes the curriculum responsibility of Humanities Co-ordinator.

Secondary Teacher of Psychology and History & Assistant Head of Sixth Form

This position involves teaching Psychology and History in the International Baccalaureate Diploma programme at the Higher and Standard levels; and History at IGCSE and UK National Curriculum Key Stage 3. This position also includes a pastoral responsibility as Assistant Head of Sixth Form.

Secondary Teacher of English & Head of Key Stage 3

This position involves teaching English Language and Literature throughout the 11-18 age range, including the UK National Curriculum Key Stage 3, IGCSE, and International Baccalaureate Diploma programme Higher and Standard levels. This position also includes a pastoral responsibility as a Head of Key Stage 3.

Secondary Teacher of Drama, Film, English and Physical Education & Head of Department

This position involves teaching Drama at UK National Curriculum Key Stage 3 and IGCSE, IB Theatre Arts and IB Film Studies levels. In addition, it involves a small amount of Physical Education and English teaching at the Key Stage 3 level. This position also includes the curriculum responsibility of Head of Department responsible for the school's annual dramatic productions and leading the development of Drama in the school.

Secondary Teacher of Business Studies and Economics & Assistant Head of Key Stage

This position involves teaching Economics at both Higher and Standard levels of the International Baccalaureate programme and IGCSE as well as Business Studies to IGCSE. This position also includes a pastoral responsibility as Assistant Head of Key Stage.

All applicants should hold a good honours degree in the main teaching subject, at least 3 years' experience in the required areas, a teacher training certificate at the appropriate level for the post and be prepared to contribute to the school's extensive co-curricular programme.

Applicants must be able to show experience in the educational programmes offered at Warwick Academy (UK National Curriculum, IGCSE/GCSE, and International Baccalaureate) or similar curricula (A-level/AP) and be able to relate positively to students, staff and parents. Proven success at external examinations is essential.

Successful applicants will be subject to a police check and must meet the requirements for the Bermuda Teacher's Licence.
