The Legal Counsel works under the supervision of the Head of the Financial Sanctions Implementation Unit (FSIU), within the Ministry of Legal Affairs Headquarters, and in accordance with ministerial policies and procedures, to lead the development and enactment process on behalf of the Government of Bermuda in respect of the regime for implementing targeted financial sanctions and combating money laundering and the financing of terrorism and proliferation; including the interpretation and application of Bermuda Law and drafting of Cabinet Memoranda in respect of such matters. The Legal Counsel will also be responsible for providing advice on legal issues where appropriate. Additionally, the Legal Counsel participates in the professional development and training, where applicable, of members of the Ministry of Legal Affairs Headquarters team and industry, in regards to the implementation of targeted financial sanctions, and in the management and administration of the Office. The Legal Counsel will also, from time to time, prepare written responses to queries/surveys/questionnaires from external agencies, including the CFATF and FATF; and perform associated legal duties, as requested by the Head of FSIU.

Applicants must be a qualified Barrister and/or Attorney of a Commonwealth jurisdiction and a member of the Bermuda Bar Association. Also, applicants must possess a minimum of five years relevant post-qualification in all aspects of AML/ATF or regulatory law in a legal environment in more than one of the following areas: money laundering and terrorist financing and proliferation, sanctions measures and AML/ATF regulation/compliance.
