This position maintains MOC's refrigeration and air conditioning units and performs regular maintenance and assists with making repairs to the reverse osmosis plant. This position also performs general equipment repairs and upgrades.

Additional responsibilities include (but not limited to):

- Maintaining and repairing MOC's air conditioning units, refrigerators, ice makers and pool pumps and keeps an inventory of standard parts and catalogues on-line related service manuals
- Creating preventative maintenance programs for refrigeration and air conditioning systems
- Conducting plumbing repairs such as leaking pipes and faucets and clogged drains
- Performing general maintenance and repairs to building structures (masonry), plumbing fixtures, furniture, woodwork, electrical and ventilation systems, appliances and equipment
- Performs additional duties as required

Minimum Qualifications, Skills and Experience:

- Advanced knowledge of general maintenance and repairs to plumbing fixtures, furnishings, woodwork, appliances, painting, plumbing, masonry, electrical work and ventilation systems
