What will your essential responsibilities include?

- Assist underwriters with treaty review/analysis during the renewals, by either carrying out the pricing directly or ensuring that the pricing is carried out using approved pricing models appropriately, depending on the complexity of the business and the guidelines in force for that region / line of business
- Ensure consistency in approaches, and where appropriate, make suggestions for improvement. Also, develop and improve actuarial methods, as part of Reinsurance Segment or regional projects
- Design and produce management information to assist underwriters and the management team
- Manage actuarial elements of the business/strategic planning process
- Coordinate with other actuaries in the region in providing actuarial support across the various regional offices. Also work with actuaries in other regions on Reinsurance Segment projects, possibly as coordinator
- Liaise with other members of the actuarial team in the region (including catastrophe modelers in other locations)
- You will act as center of competence for a particular line of business
- You may manage small team of junior staff
- Part of your responsibilities will be to monitor natural catastrophe and other peak exposures
- You will report to Bermuda and London Head of Reinsurance Pricing & Analytics, Reinsurance Pricing
- You will be involved in helping with the reserving for the Bermuda portfolio of business and using this information to help inform the pricing work that you will be involved in
