Additionally, the Senior Account Executive will be responsible for the day to day operational management of the catastrophe bond platform within the ILS team.

- Manage and direct the services provided to large multi-national clients with complex insurance programs specializing in the ILS market including the development, structuring, licensing, and management of natural catastrophe bonds, transformers, sidecars, and other ILS products;
- Oversee the audit process and regulatory reporting;
- Be familiar with US tax issues/implications including FATCA and PFIC reporting;
- Update the policies and procedures manual on an asneeded basis in order to keep up with the ever changing ILS marketplace;
- Assist in various ad-hoc initiatives as required to improve efficiency and productivity of the ILS platform;
- Participate in new business activities when necessary including making presentations to prospective clients.
