EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES AT BHS

BHS, an International Baccalaureate School based in Bermuda, is an all-girls school from the Early Years Programme to Year 11 and offers an IB co-ed programme in Years 12 and 13 (IB1 & IB2). The School offers the International Primary Curriculum, the English National Curriculum through Key Stage 1-3, the (I)GCSE curriculum in Years 10 and 11, and the IB Diploma and Courses in the final two years of the School. Students may also sit the SAT examinations in IB1/IB2.

At BHS we focus on the balanced learner, providing extensive opportunities for advancement in academics, the arts, athletics, STEAM, community service and leadership development. BHS promotes a student-centred approach to pedagogy and learning.

We are currently seeking the following teachers for September 2019:

Teacher of Business Subjects, Geography, PSHE, PE, Head of Year and Duke of Edinburgh Awards Leader

This position requires the teaching of Business Subjects and Economics to the (I)GCSE Level and IB Standard/Higher Diploma Levels. This position also involves the teaching of Personal Social Health Education (PSHE), Physical Education (PE), Geography and the pastoral leadership of a Year group. Previous leadership experience in this pastoral role is essential. The successful candidate may also be responsible for the coordination of all aspects of the Duke of Edinburgh Awards programme. Experience with this programme would be a benefit.

Teacher of English, PSHE, TOK, Global Citizenship and Head of Year

This position requires the teaching of English including (I)GCSE and IB Diploma Standard and Higher Levels. As the school begins to develop the new Middle Years programme, experience in thematic cross-curricular teaching would be an advantage. Excellent results at the (I)GCSE and post 16 examinations are essential. The successful candidate may be required, at times, to teach PSHE (Personal, Social Health Education), Global Citizenship and IB TOK (Theory of Knowledge). This position may also involve the pastoral leadership of a year group, so experience in that area will be a benefit.

Teacher of English, Drama, PSHE, TOK, Global Citizenship and Head of Year (One year only)

This position requires the teaching of English including (I)GCSE and IB Diploma Standard and Higher Levels. As the school begins to develop the new Middle Years programme, experience in thematic cross-curricular teaching would be an advantage. Excellent results at the (I)GCSE and post 16 examinations are essential. The successful candidate may be required, at times, to teach PSHE (Personal, Social Health Education), Drama, Global Citizenship and IB TOK (Theory of Knowledge). This position may also involve the pastoral leadership of a year group, so experience in that area will be a benefit.

Part-time Primary Art Teacher

This position involves teaching up to 3 lessons a week of Primary Art. Applicants must hold a teaching degree at the Bachelor level or higher and formal training in teaching Art in various disciplines.

All teacher applicants should hold strong academic qualifications: a Bachelor's degree in the teaching subject and teacher training certification. Proven success, formal training and a minimum of 3 years' experience in teaching the subject would be a requirement for these vacancies. A willingness to contribute to the school's extensive extracurricular programme is essential. Prospective teachers should also be comfortable with the use of technology in the classroom. All applicants must meet the requirements for the Bermuda Teachers' License.

We are currently seeking the following Afterschool Care/Holiday Staff for September 2019:

Afterschool/Holiday Care Coordinator

This position involves active day-to-day involvement in the organization and management of a multi-activity based Afterschool Care Programme and an engaging, theme-based Holiday Camp Programme; including managing all related paperwork (e.g. billing, attendance sheets) and creating flyers. The successful candidate will also be required to supervise staff and assist with recruitment. Proven ability to lead a team of adult staff and strong communication and organization skills are necessary.

Afterschool/Holiday Care Staff – 1 position

This position involves supervising and working with children ages 3 – 11 years old, both afterschool and during school holidays. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, assisting with registration and the organization, set up and break down of various activities.

All Afterschool/Holiday Care applicants must have a recognized certificate or degree in education or a comparable area of expertise and at least 3 years of ongoing experience supervising and working with children, ages 3 - 11 years old, in a well reputed educational setting, camp or Afterschool programme. Both jobs require someone who is energetic, enthusiastic, nurturing and flexible. Candidates must be CPR/First Aid certified.

Applicants for any of the above positions are asked to provide the following information: Post applied for, full name, date of birth and nationality, full details of Secondary and Higher Education with dates, full qualifications with dates, full details of teaching and other experience and **three** written professional references with their contact information. One of these references should be from a supervisor at the current place of employment. The successful candidates for all positions will be expected to provide a recent Police background check and complete SCARS training in order to demonstrate that they may work in an organisation involving children.
